

 - Click on "Switch user" if it is not yours – Other user – username + password (e-mail)

 - Open the personal folder
 - Type the name of the measure to be performed in the "name" section and click the "save" button
 - Run-measurement (Scan button)
 - Answer YES to the question "Save changes"
 - Creating a personal folder during the first use**
 - Run points 1-5
 - Click on the icon (third top right) "Create a new folder"
 - Enter the name of the personal folder
 - Click on the "Open" button
 - Enter the name of the measurement to be performed in the "Name" section and click the "Save" button
 - Run-measurement (Scan button)
 - Answer YES to the question "Save changes"
 - For those who have the opportunity to reach their files PRIVATE, PUBLIC, etc., you can save your data on one of these files. Otherwise use a USB key to transfer to your computer.
How to reach your data on the disk
1. Start windows, click on "Computer"
2. Open Windows Disk (C :)
3. Open the folder named Odyssey
4. Open the personnel file
 - If the data has been stored in a PUBLIC folder, you can find them from any computer institute. If they have been saved in a PRIVATE folder, you will have to start your session from any computer of the institute in order to retrieve them.
